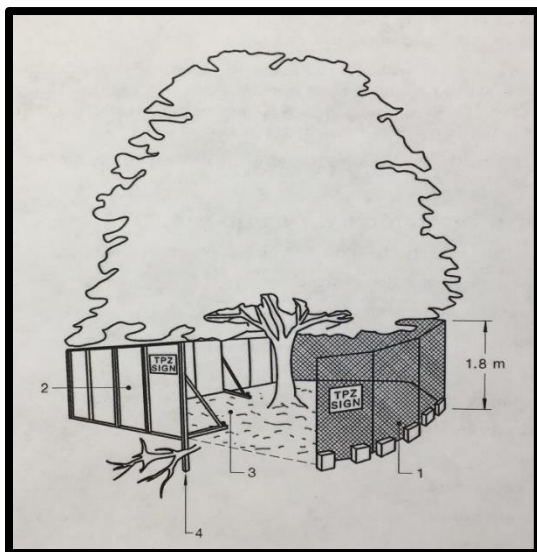


TREE PROTECTION ZONES (TPZ) REQUIRE SIGNAGE. TPZ signs shall be installed at regular intervals around the fencing to clearly indicate that entry and storage are prohibited. For example:

KEEP OUT OF TREE PROTECTION ZONES

- FENCING MAY NOT BE REMOVED
- NO PERSON SHALL ENTER THE AREA
- NO MACHINERY SHALL ENTER THE AREA
- NO MATERIALS SHALL BE STORED IN THE AREA
- NO DEBRIS SHALL BE STORED IN THE AREA
- NO EXCAVATION SHALL OCCUR IN THE AREA

ANY INCURSION INTO THE AREA WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT OF THE CITY FORESTER IS SUBJECT TO FINES. Call 970-429-4031



FENCING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Chain link or wire mesh panels with cloth covering, held in place with metal plate or concrete feet, minimum 6' ft tall
 2. Alternative plywood or chip board fence panels. This must also prevent soil or building materials from entering the TPZ like the cloth covering for wire mesh
 3. Mulch installation across the surface of the TPZ (at the discretion of the City Forester)
 4. Posts and Bracing are permissible within the TPZ but should be positioned to avoid roots
- *Fencing shall be installed at the dripline unless otherwise agreed with the City Forester
